- (e) Critically discuss the Meena-Sam Lowbridge relationship in *Anita and Me*.
- (f) Discuss some of the pertinent concerns of the diaspora that Jhumpa Lahiri addresses in *The Namesake*. Cite instances from the novel to develop your argument.
- (g) From your reading of *The Book of Secrets*, discuss some of the immigrant experiences as reflected in the narrative.
- (h) Critically comment on Rohinton Mistry's choice of *A Fine Balance* as the title of his novel.

- (i) What role does history play in the novel, *Anita and Me*?
- (j) Discuss Ashima's feeling of alienation in the United States.
