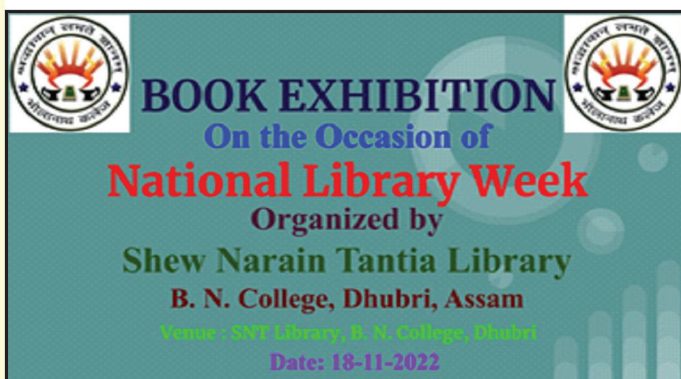

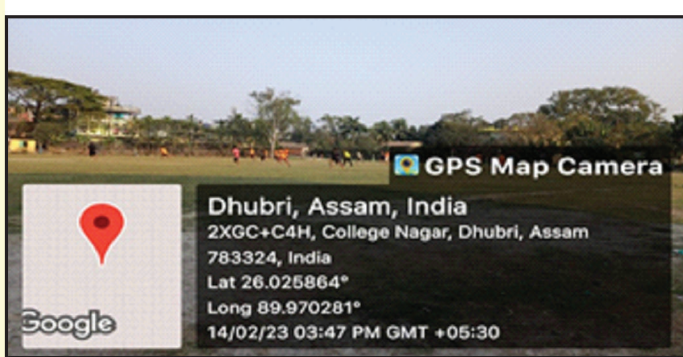
A+ ACCREDITATION TO B.N. COLLEGE, DHUBRI **DATE : 07-02-2023**

CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY 2023

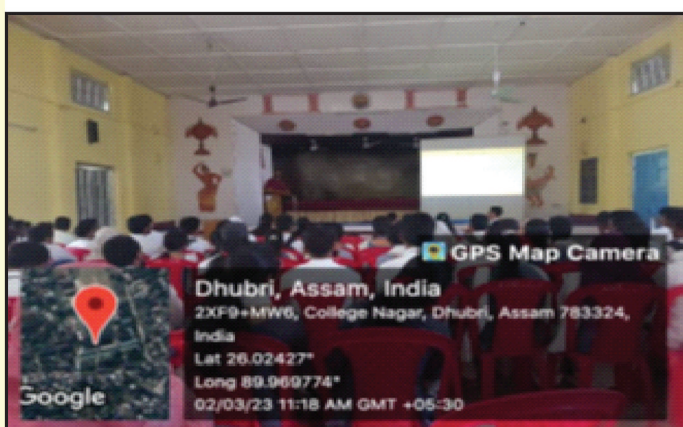
DATE : 28-02-2023

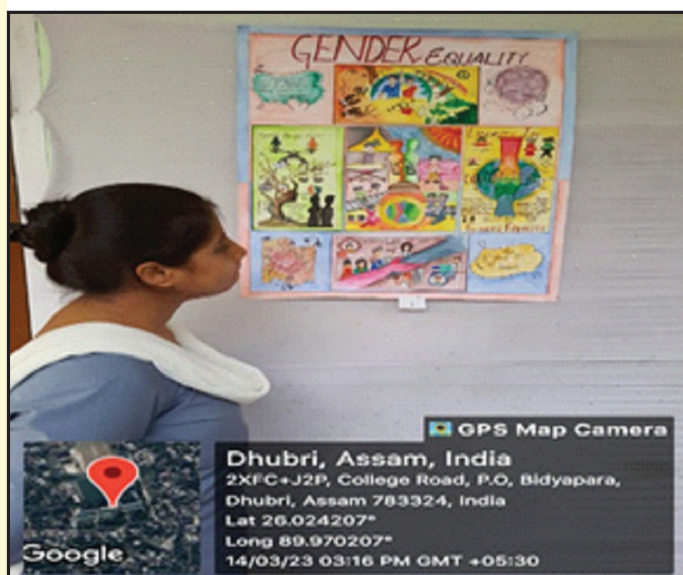
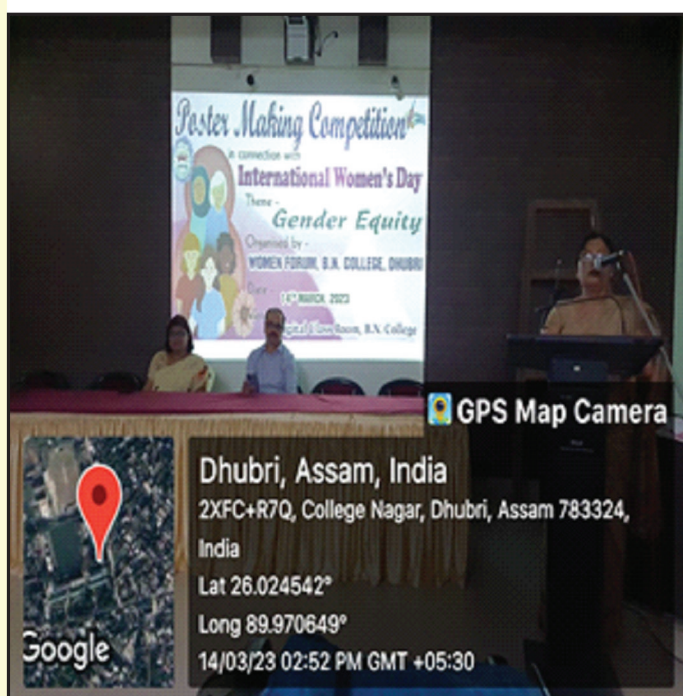
WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY **DATE : 28-02-2023 & 02-03-2023**

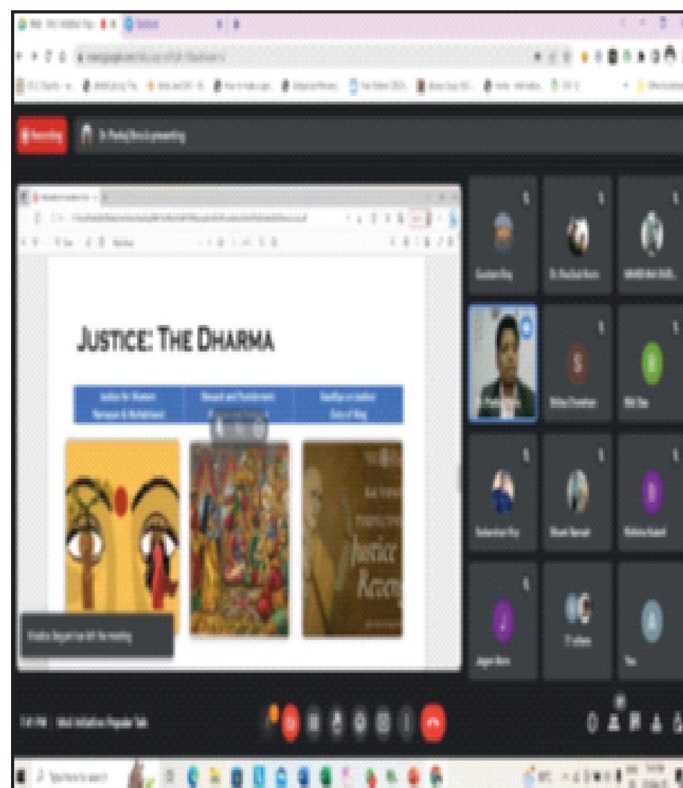
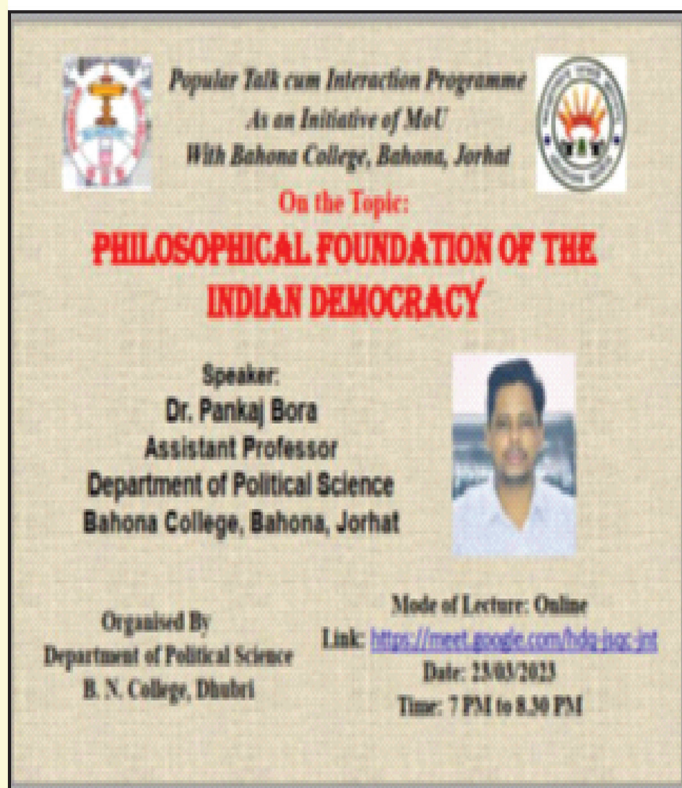


POPULAR TALK ON “PHILOSOPHICAL FOUNDATION OF THE INDIAN DEMOCRACY”

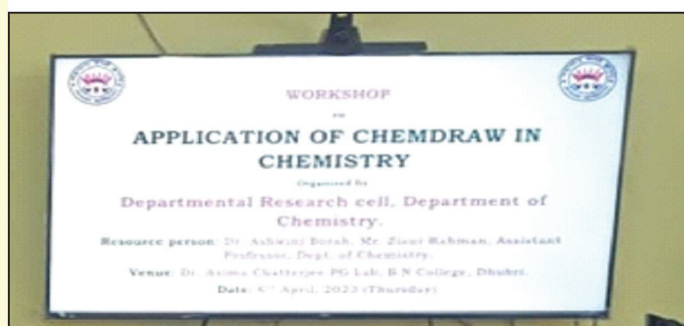


WORKSHOP ON APPLICATION OF CHEMDRAW IN CHEMISTRY

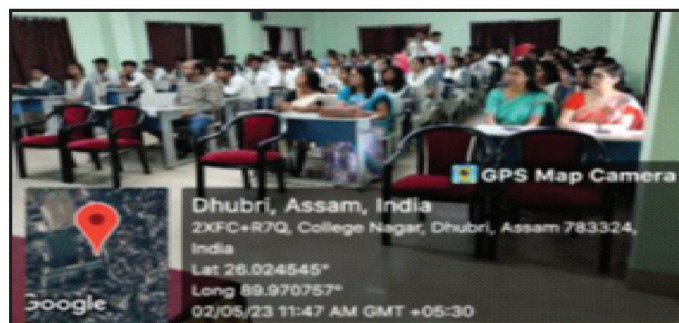
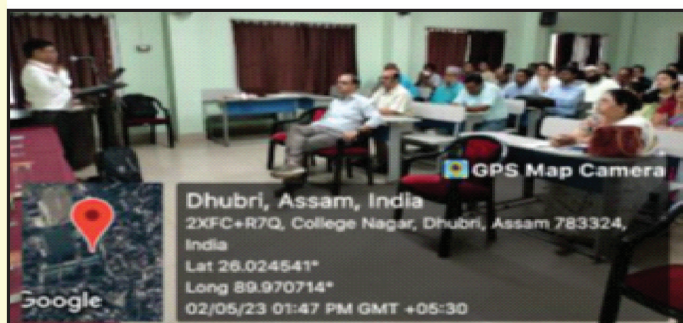

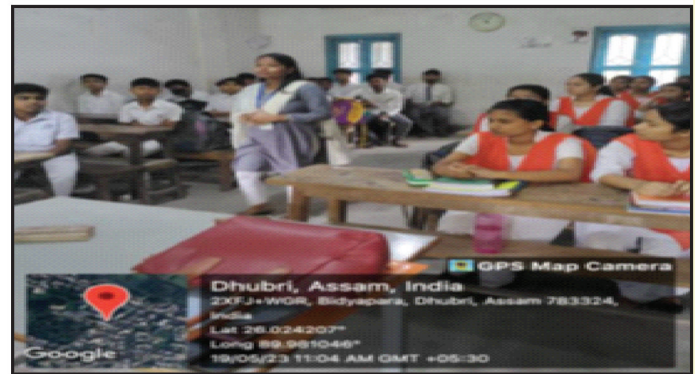
